MULTIPLE RENDERING PROVIDERS IN ONE DAY

UPDATE

MARCH 23, 2018

As previously informed, the Maryland Department of Health and Beacon have resolved the billing issue with multiple ABA providers rendering direct services to a member on the same day. Providers can now begin submitting claims for two or more Medicaid enrolled staff who render direct ABA therapy to the same participant in a single day. These claims will now be paid for any services rendered since January 1, 2017.

Here is an example of how providers should submit these claims:

One staff works with a member for 1 hour before school. A different staff goes to the member's house for an additional 2-hour session that evening.

In this example, the claim should be submitted as follows:

1st staff: Bill one unit of 0364T for the first 30 minutes of service
Bill 0365T for each remaining 30-minute period of service

2nd staff: Bill 0365T for each remaining 30-minute period of service
