New Fee Schedules for Behavioral Health and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Providers - Effective January 1, 2024

December 6, 2023

Target Audience: All Behavioral Health Providers

Effective January 1, 2024, Maryland Medicaid will increase certain behavioral health provider rates. Community-based behavioral health providers and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) providers will receive an 8% rate increase.

Optum Maryland is implementing the 8% rate updates for Behavioral Health and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) providers for dates of service January 1, 2024, and forward.

Please note: E&M codes, laboratories, and J & Q codes will not receive the 8% increase.
