- 2. On April 26, 2024, Optum delivered letters to providers who have an estimated payment balance with a balloon payment due on June 30, 2024. The letter directs the provider to complete <u>this survey</u> to advise Optum and the Maryland Department of Health of their preference for managing their balloon payment.
  - Letters were delivered to the Download folder within Incedo. Please look for the filename beginning "EPSurvey"
  - Please review the information in your letter and complete this survey by the end of day on May 10, 2024.
- 3. Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is now live in Incedo. All users will need to set-up MFA for their own, individual log-in credential.
  - If multiple users at one location are sharing a single log-in credential, contact your system administrator to have an individual account enabled. Instructions for adding users are given in the "Managing Users in the Incedo Provider Portal" training video.
    - Sharing a log-in between staff presents a security risk to the provider organization and participant data. Providers who continue to share a single log-in credential between multiple staff members may have their Incedo account deactivated.
